The Sloan Research Fellowships are now supporting those who do their best work underwater.

Early-career researchers in the ocean sciences are now eligible for Sloan Research Fellowships. For the first time since this fellowship program began in 1955, the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation will convene a panel of senior ocean scientists to serve as one of its selection committees.

Eight awards of \$50,000 will honor junior faculty who teach at U.S. and Canadian institutions for their creativity, promise, and independent accomplishments as ocean science researchers. Former fellows in other fields include 38 Nobel Laureates, 16 Fields Medalists, and 11 John Bates Clark Medalists.

To be considered for a Sloan Research Fellowship, candidates must be nominated by a department chair or senior researcher before September 15, 2011.
